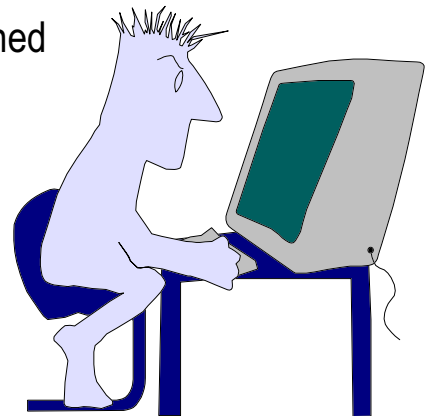


Top Ten Reasons Not to Sign on to the USY Listserv!
